# 100th anniversary of biodynamic agriculture

#### Preparations and events

2023 was a year of preparation for the 100th anniversary of the biodynamic impulse that came into being at Whitsun 1924 with Rudolf Steiner's Agriculture Course, given on the Koberwitz estate. A range of publications and a free online course enabled all those interested to prepare the material for the anniversary. In addition, two special occasions were planned: the large international anniversary conference in February 2024 and a regional anniversary celebration at Whitsun.

The Circle of Representatives of the Section for Agriculture met in autumn 2023 in Donji Kraljevec in Croatia. This was Rudolf Steiner's birthplace, as his father was an official who worked at the railway station there. The Genius loci helped us to gather the strength to delve into the depths and connect to Rudolf Steiner's momentous stream of creativity, as some of the contributions in the Circular 124 show.

# International anniversary conference with around 1,000 participants

### Sun – Earth – Human. 100 years of the Agricultural Course

As a prelude to the Agriculture Conference 2024 the professional groups and Sarah Sommer organised a fantastic tasting evening to celebrate biodynamic quality. On 7 February 2024 the time had come: the big anniversary conference began. The conference, which ran until 10 February, was a sell-out, with around 1,000 participants from 51 countries in attendance. The «seed» to help society rediscover agriculture for the future was shared through lectures, panel discussions, workshops, Open Spaces, artistic courses and exhibitions. It spread in the hearts of all the participants at the Goetheanum, which was positively humming with life and human warmth. We wish to thank all the visitors, contributors, sponsors and supporters as well as the Goetheanum team for this wonderful celebration!

## Open doors day on Whit Sunday 2024 – bringing biodynamics to life

### Earth – Plant – Animal – Human. Celebrating 100 years of biodynamic agriculture together

The international anniversary conference in February was followed by a regional anniversary celebration on Whit Sunday, 19 May 2024. Around 800 people took up the invitation from the Garden Department and the Section for Agriculture to celebrate the centenary of biodynamic agriculture and to honour the earth and everything that it gives us. The aim of the celebration was to bring biodynamics to life through workshops on the natural kingdoms of earth, plant, animal and human, tours through the Goetheanum garden park and a market with regional biodynamic products. ## Well attended online course

#### Training

As preparation for the anniversary, we offered a free online course «Biodynamics and anthroposophy», led by Jean-Michel Florin, Ueli Hurter and Sarah Sommer, with 600 registrations from across the world. Further courses on the topics of «Associative economics», «Animals» and «Food» continued the online course programme that was launched in 2021. Within three years a kind of mini online university has emerged, with the courses attracting keen interest.

## Successful development of the international research platform

#### Research communication and coordination

Research communication has made great progress: the international Biodynamic Research Platform was set up in 2023 and now has over 170 members from around 20 countries. In the run-up to the anniversary conference the members met for a Biodynamic Research Day, which will now take place annually. In addition to this meeting, there have been online seminars on current research topics and study reports have been published at regular intervals.

# Further development and deepening of «dynamic nutrition»

#### Nutrition department

Published for the anniversary conference, the new handbook by Dr. Jasmin Peschke «From Food System to Food Organism» describes a transformation and includes exercises for success. In addition, Dr. Jasmin Peschke gave various seminars, (online) courses and lectures throughout the world on the topic of food, and jointly published regular articles on current topics in nutrition in four languages with the nutrition advisor, Lea Sprügel.

## New professional direction

#### Sustainable development

The research co-worker Johannes Kronenberg joined the Section team, bringing with him the new professional area of «Sustainable Development». He is currently working on a compendium, which will present the contributions by anthroposophy to sustainable development by means of case studies from anthroposophical institutions and companies.

## A wide range of publications

### Communications

The book «Biodynamisch! Geburtsstunde der biodynamischen Landwirtschaft am Ausgangspunkt der Ökobewegung» (Biodynamic! Birth of biodynamic agriculture at the starting point of the environmental movement) by Rudi Bind and Ueli Hurter was published in June 2023. The objective description of the historical development of the biodynamic impulse combats current attacks by the media and served as preparation for the anniversary. The Living Farms project also produced 22 podcast episodes with interesting personalities from the Section's worldwide network. And as the third new development we are pleased to announce the enclosed Section for Agriculture Magazine: here you can read more detailed information on our activities mentioned in the Review.
